Try phrasing it like this:

Goal: Design a warm, welcoming 90-minute workshop that helps everyday adults understand artificial intelligence without jargon.

Description: Picture a Saturday morning in a cozy public library — sunlight, coffee, and friendly conversation. The group is curious but cautious about AI.

Instruction: Write an outline with clear learning objectives and a flow that builds comfort, understanding, and hands-on confidence. Use plain, encouraging language.

That structure signals **intent (goal first)**, adds **precise metadata (setting, tone, audience)**, and uses **logical order** to guide the Al's response.



PROMPTING IS THE NEW REFERENCE INTERVIEW

- Every great AI interaction starts with a clear, thoughtful question
- Librarians already do this it's the reference interview turned inward
- Good prompts include tone, audience, and purpose
- Refinement is collaboration, not correction



- Precise details setting, tone, and audience shape what the Al creates
- Logical order matters more than word order
- State the goal up front

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





ACCELERATE CREATION — STAY THE AUTHOR

- Al accelerates the setup, not the story.
- Use AI to brainstorm and outline keep the voice human.
- Automation extends your reach; judgment defines your value.
- The faster the draft, the stronger the finish.







- Prompt Begin with clear intent: define your role, your audience, and the format you want.
- Assess Read critically: compare the result to your goal, not the model's confidence.
- **Iterate** Adjust what's missing or off; refine one element at a time.
- Record Capture what worked and why, so your best prompts become your next starting point.

USING THE PAIR FRAMEWORK

- Draft a newsletter → use Prompt and Iterate to find your tone
- Plan an event → Assess relevance, clarity, and audience fit
- Build a how-to guide → Record your best prompts for next time
- Apply once reuse often

- Prompting is the new reference interview better questions lead to better results
- Describe before you generate clarity drives quality
- Accelerate creation stay the author use AI to work faster, not think less
- PAIR your repeatable framework for assistive Al fluency
